Carli is also making soap which she will also be making available.

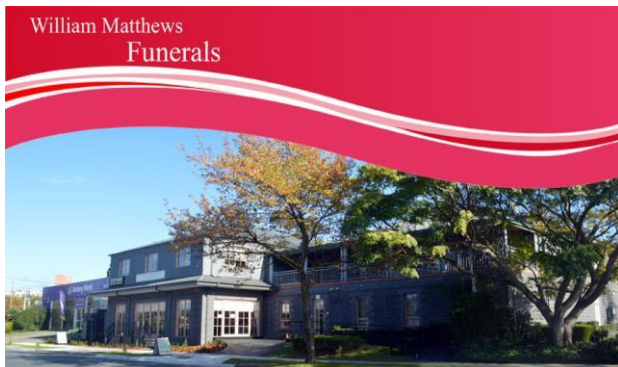
